## Wings of Spring

Size: 6.5" unfinished

Background: soft yellow / deep cream / very light tan / low-volume, tone-on-tone

Wings: two contrasting colors and textures


Examples:

Fabric A -- green with multi polka dots; Fabric B -- pink with squiggles

Fabric A – purple floral; Fabric B – light blue geometric

FOR THE LOTTO: You may enter up to nine blocks. You may repeat fabrics as long as each combination is unique. No twins!

Cutting:



Background – 2 rectangles, 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" 2 squares, 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" 2 squares, 3" x 3" Fabric A: 1 square, 3" x 3" Fabric B: 1 square, 3" x 3"

Note that I made HSTs by rounding up and cutting down. You may make HSTs by a different method. The unfinished size is  $2-1/2^{"}$  to finish at  $2^{"}$ .

Sewing:

Layer Fabric A 3" square onto a background 3" square, right sides together. Slice diagonally. Sew along the diagonals with a ¼" seam to make two HSTs. Trim to 2.5". Repeat with Fabric B. Press HSTs open.

Assemble to create block as shown.
